WIDA ACCESS	Grades K-6	Administered to English learners to measure progress toward meeting the WIDA English Language Development Standards adopted by Minnesota.	February 26 - March 15
NWEA	Grades K-6	NWEA assessments are designed to target a student's academic performance in mathematics, reading, language usage, and science. These tests are tailored to an individual's current achievement level.
